Join this neighborhood stroll around Portuguese Hill that begins inside Our Lady of Good Voyage Church on Prospect Street and listen as parish priest Father Alves speaks about the history of this Gloucester landmark. The church is built in a style of architecture familiar to the Azorean culture and is viewed by many residents as the center of their neighborhood community, while its statues and motifs focus

upon Mary as the Mother of God and the ships that have helped to provide a livelihood for generations of fishermen and their families. On the surrounding streets, a short walk to other points of interest is led by curator Martha Oaks with commentary added by David Rose and Raphael Oliver Sr., two members of the community with multi-generational ties to the area.
