View an exhibit that was curated by Patricia Stark Feinstein and presented by the Cape Ann Museum from September 10 through November 6, 2011, that features Sam Feinstein (1915-2003), a Philadelphia-based painter who summered in Gloucester in the mid-1940s. Included are pieces from Feinstein's time on Cape Ann as well as later works, in addition to some that have never been previously shown. The exhibition captures Feinstein's foray into expressionism and

subsequent movement towards greater abstraction. For more insight into the dynamics that helped to shape Feinstein's endeavors, watch "Hans Hofmann" and Sam Feinstein: The Artist's Search, another video in the museum's archives that captures a lecture by Patricia Stark Feinstein in which she presents a slideshow and discussion centered upon the documentary film that Sam Feinstein made about his friend and teacher Hans Hofmann.
